Re: Packaging and Shipping Guidelines for Specimens Submitted Through Local Health

Departments

The North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) requests assistance from Local Health Department (LHD) laboratories to ensure all specimens submitted to NCSLPH through the LHD are appropriately packaged and stored for shipping through the NC DOA Medical Courier.

All samples submitted by external agencies through the LHD must adhere to the NCSLPH packaging and shipping guidance. Specimens must be stored at the appropriate temperature, packaged in bags or cans, and placed in NC DOA Medical Courier bags with the appropriate transport temperature label on the Medical Courier bag. Specimens should not be placed in a box or any other container unless specified in NCSLPH packaging and shipping guidance.

LHDs are responsible for communicating the packaging and shipping requirements to external submitters for any specimens brought to the LHD for shipping through the NC DOA Medical Courier. These submitters should be referred to the <a href="NCSLPH">NCSLPH</a> packaging and shipping guidance. Shipping supplies can be ordered from the <a href="NCSLPH">NCSLPH</a> website.

While it is not the responsibility of the LHD to repackage samples from external agencies, if a partner agency fails to comply with the packaging requirements, LHDs are asked to provide additional guidance or refer the agency to NCSLPH Customer Service for assistance. Specimens that are not packaged and stored correctly, including those in standalone boxes, may be rejected for pickup by the NC DOA Medical Courier.
